Education Week is HERE

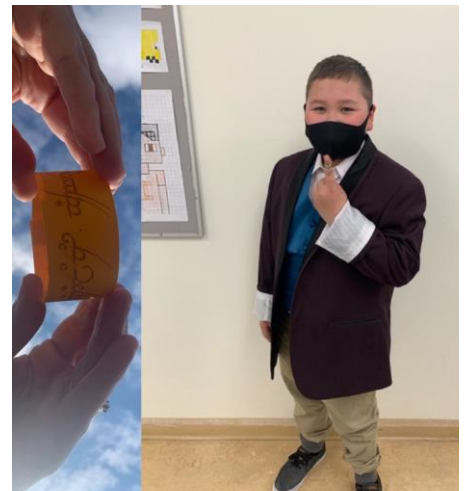
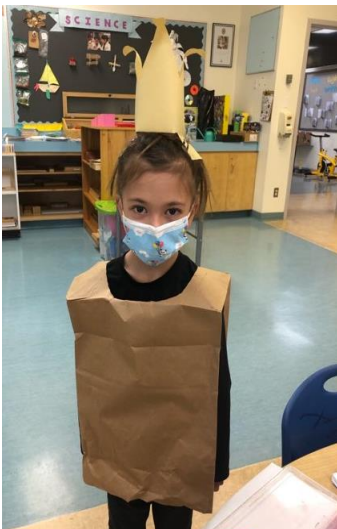
May 3-7 is Education Week in Alberta.
