There are three ways to say September in Blackfoot: Traditionally, Blackfoot people didn't have a 12 month calendar like we have today. They kept track of the time of year by observing patterns in seasonal changes.

1. awakaasiiki'somm -- deer moon
2. iitaipa'ksikini'kaayi pakki' pistsi -- when cherries are mushy
3. iitaomatapapitsitsisko -- when the leaves change colour (Blackfoot Dictionary, 2017).
