#### COLD WEATHER PROCEDURES

When cold weather strikes, we still feel it is very important for our students to get outside for some fresh air, sunshine, and movement every day. Our students will continue to go outside for recess throughout the winter, unless the weather (including wind chill) makes this unsafe (below -20C).

Please ensure your child comes to school prepared for outside play each and every day. Weather can change quickly and drastically in southern Alberta so having a toque, mittens, winter boots, a winter jacket, and snow pants is very important. We also encourage our youngest students to practice getting these items on and off independently as they greatly outnumber the staff that is here to help them.

It is also very helpful to drop your children off as close to the 8:20 bell time as possible so they are not waiting outside for too long. THANK YOU!
