LUNCHES AND SNACKS

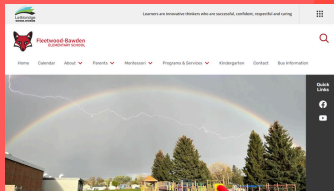

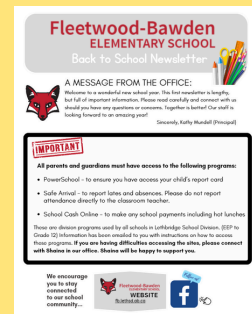
