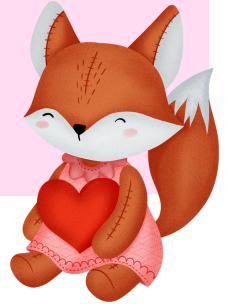


# Fleetwood-Bawden ELEMENTARY SCHOOL February Newsletter
